TAEASS413 Participate in assessment validation requires you to demonstrate your ability to participate in the validation of assessment tools, practices and judgements in:

- Pre-assessment validation of assessment tools before they are first used with candidates, and post-assessment validation of the tools after having been used to assess candidates
- Post-assessment validation of practices and judgements
- The Standards define validation as the quality review of the assessment process. Validation involves checking that the assessment tools produce valid, reliable, sufficient, current, and authentic evidence to enable reasonable judgements to be made as to whether the requirements of the training package or VET-accredited courses are met. It includes reviewing a statistically valid sample of the assessments and making recommendations for future improvements to the assessment tool, process and/or outcomes and acting upon such recommendations

Most importantly - all validations completed in the assessment cluster must be led by an experienced VET practitioner e.g. Trainer, Assessor, Teacher, Compliance Manager, RTO Manager and there must be at least two (2) other participants in the validation meeting.

Ideally the validation meetings are conducted in class, however, if you are studying by yourself, you will need to either:

- meet with an experienced VET practitioner (who will play the role of the lead validator)
- or book a support call with a Blueprint trainer (who will be the lead validator for your meeting)
